

Seed Bombs

Materials

-  Wildflower seeds (native to your area)
-  Soil
-  Clay

Students will learn about the plant life cycle as they watch their seed bombs explode with life.

Directions:

1. Take a quarter sized ball of clay and flatten it out into a circle.
2. Place 10-15 seeds on the clay and press them in.
3. Sprinkle a thin layer of soil onto your clay to cover the seeds.
4. Roll your clay back up into a ball.
5. Roll the ball in soil to cover the outside. You now have a seed bomb!
6. Toss or plant your seed bomb wherever you see the need for some color!
