Students will learn about the plant life cycle as they watch their seed bombs explode with life. K - 2nd Grade

Directions:

- 1. Take a quarter sized ball of clay and flatten it out into a circle.
- 2. Place 10-15 seeds on the clay and press them in.
- 3. Sprinkle a thin layer of soil onto your clay to cover the seeds.
- 4. Roll your clay back up into a ball.
- 5. Roll the ball in soil to cover the outside. You now have a seed bomb!
- 6. Toss or plant your seed bomb wherever you see the need for some color!
